Please ensure everything is clearly named and do not bring 'new' items of clothing.

***This is a kit list for guidance.***

<b>Bedding</b>	Pillow and duvet with cover or sleeping bag. Bottom sheet provided.
<b>Clothes</b>	Nightwear
	Underwear (enough for a change each day and spares)
	Pairs of socks (including spares)
	Trousers – no jeans ( <i>Long trousers needed for harness activity</i> )
	Shorts ( <i>for warm weather</i> )
	T-Shirts
	Long sleeved top ( <i>Long sleeves are needed for rope activities and archery</i> )
	Jumper/Sweatshirt/Fleece
	Waterproof Jacket/ coat with a hood ( <i>for wet weather</i> )
	1 set of clothes for the water activity - Shorts and t-shirt over swimwear.
	A pair of shoes for the water activity that will get wet. Beach shoes or old shoes are ideal. No crocs or flip flops. It must be a proper shoe.
	At least two towels (one for water activity and one for bathing)
	Trainers or other substantial footwear for daytime activities
<b>Toiletries</b>	Wash bag
	Toothbrush/Toothpaste
	Deodorant – roll on, not spray due to fire alarms in the dorms.
	Flannel/sponge
	Soap/Shower Gel
	Hair products i.e. shampoo/conditioner
	Hair ties (for long hair)
	Hair brush/comb
<b>Other</b>	Hand sanitiser and tissues
	Sunglasses and prescription glasses if needed
	Water bottle <b>clearly named *</b>
	Cap/Sun hat
	Sun cream
	Small torch for night time
	Small travel games, pens, paper, book to read for use in dormitories
	2 x bag for dirty clothes
	Purse or wallet – <b>named – limit of money £10.00</b>

All of their kit should be packed into 1 holdall/bag/small suitcase that is named plus a bag with their bedding. Please encourage your child to pack their bag with you so they know what they have. They also need to be able to carry the bag themselves.

\*A water bottle is **very** important. They will fill this up and use it throughout the day.
