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Dear Parents and Carers

Since writing to you back in May with my Welcome Letter, I would like to give you some more information relating to your child's start with us in September. I always look forward to this time of year when we invite you to come along to the Endowed to take a glimpse into what junior school life is like.

We are especially looking forward to **Thursday 2nd July**, which is our transition morning and I have explained below the plans for that morning. When you arrive at the school, please bring your child to our playground by 8.50am, where their new class teachers will be waiting to greet them. Our Family Liaison Officer, Miss Parker, will be available to chat with parents and carers and pre-loved uniform will be on sale. I will also be available, alongside Mrs Hewitt and Mr Bowles, our Assistant Headteachers. The children will have a fun morning with lots of activities and an opportunity to get to know their new teachers and to have lunch and play in the playground.

Westmeads and St Alphege will provide and deliver packed lunches on this day, so do please let your Infant School know if you wish your child to have a school packed lunch or whether you will send them with their own from home, thank you. The children will be walked back to their Infant schools by Endowed staff at 12.30pm. Children who will be joining us from other infant schools will need to be collected from the school office at 12.30pm on that day and will need to provide a packed lunch from home.

This meeting is ideally just for parents and carers due to the amount of information we need to pass on to you. We hope you will pop along afterwards and visit the Year 3 classrooms.

In the new academic year, you will have the opportunity to visit your child's class again and hear more about what they will be learning at school, together with any other information about our school.

My door is always open and I really encourage an open and honest relationship between us as partners in your child's education. We are all very excited about embarking on a four-year journey with you; roll on September!
