NETBALL V HOATH

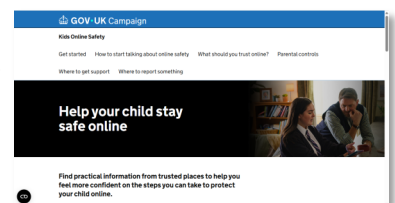
