You might not be aware that you can change your details yourself on the **My Child at School** app. You simply need to go to the Dashboard and select 'Data Collection Form' and can change address, phone number etc from there. If you make any changes you then need to ensure you click 'Submit Changes'.

Within the Data Collection form you can also change the 'Priority' of parents who both live in the same house. Communications are normally just sent to 'Priority 1' parents, so if one of the parents is 'Priority 2' and not receiving documents, they can change their priority on MCAS. The school are notified of any changes that you make.

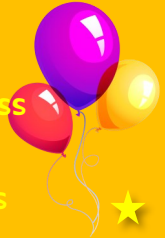
